

MOUNTAIN MAN CONTEST

FIND OUT WHO THE REAL MEN ARE!

April 27 and 28 at Camp PARSONS 2018

Arrive Friday night any time after 5:00 p.m. and leave Saturday at 5:00 p.m.



All Scouts ages 14-16 across the Council will compete against one another in several Mountain Man contests. The winner will take home a traveling trophy with their Unit number engraved name on it.

Poulsbo Team 1570 won the trophy in 2017.

Who will win it in 2018?

A scout must be between 14 and 16 as of April 28, 2018 to compete in this event.

Scouts from any troop across the entire Chief Seattle Council can participate, including Venturing Crews, but the age limit still applies.

This event was previously for Varsity Teams only, but there are very few in the Council at this time, so it is now open to all Troops, but the age limit of 14-16 as of the day of the event will apply since this is a High Adventure Scouting

The competitions include such items as:

Black Powder rifle

Single man canoe paddle around a buoy and back

Tomahawk Throw, Spear Toss and Knife Throwing

Wood stack and carry contest

The famous John Colter Run: strength and speed.

Obstacle Course

The Bunge Cord Pull

Shelter building from local materials

Each event is based on the Troop having at least five members who will work as a team to compete in each event. (If you have less than five, combine with another troop.)

Cost is \$10.00 per scout. This is to cover the camp, the Friday night Cracker Barrel and Black Powder.

The entire Camp Parsons has been reserved for this event. We have bunk houses for every one until all are filled. If you arrive after 7:00 p.m. bring tents just in case all bunks houses are full.
